



GENERAL RULES

No alcohol, illegal substances or weapons allowed on the fairgrounds. No animals are allowed on the fairgrounds unless they are exhibiting or are in use as a service animal. Exhibiting animals are only allowed in the specific show area.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES ON THE GROUNDS. Only authorized vehicles are allowed, or ones that have paid the \$25.00 sticker fee can be used on the fairgrounds. Some areas are totally restricted from these. A map can be obtained when the vehicle is registered. Handicapped vehicles are exempt from registration fee.

The Lake County Fair will take every precaution to properly protect exhibits and/or animals. However, we will not be liable for the safety of exhibits, animals, exhibitors, employees, or families. Nor will we be liable for losses or damages sustained due to vandalism, theft, weather, fire, accidents, or any other cause. Exhibitors wishing to insure themselves, their belongings, or their livestock may do so at their own expense.

RULES AND REGULATIONS DRAFT HORSES, FARM TEAMS, MULES AND PONIES/HALFLINGERS

1. Entries close July 28, 2010, OR WHEN THE BARN FILLS UP. There is a fee of \$8.00 per head, payable with entry, **AND A \$5.00 OFFICE FEE.**
2. Each exhibitor must purchase an exhibitor's ticket for \$12.00 to admit exhibitor during Fair.
3. A stall fee for each animal housed in the barn or tent is due with your entry form. \$8.00 per stall.
4. Exhibitors may arrive anytime after 12 Noon on Wednesday, August 10th and **SHOULD BE IN PLACE BY 4 P.M.**
- IF SHOWING THAT NIGHT.
5. MULES AND FARM TEAMS working out of their trucks or trailers may come in Thursday **BEFORE 3:00 P.M.**
