Championships – In order to enter a championship class, you must have shown in a class in the same division.

Stabling – Stabling is done at the discretion of the horse show management. Every effort will be made to accommodate exhibitor's requests.

Pre-Entry and Stabling Request Deadline July 20, 2010

ENTRY FORMS – Pre-Entry: All entry forms must be signed by the owner and/or trainer (as agent) if applicable and stall and entry fees must accompany the entry form. Pre-Entry acceptable method(s) of payment is a check or money order made out to the Lake County Fair. If you prefer, a signed, blank check may accompany your pre-entries and constitutes payment. All tabs must be settled by Sunday at the end of the afternoon session.

Post-Entry: Entries may be made at the show at no additional charge. **However, stall requests must be done with an entry form by the deadline.** For proper entry into the computer, please enter at least one class. You are not committed to that class and can make changes once you arrive on the grounds. Phone orders for stalls **WILL NOT** be accepted.

PLEASE NOTE: This show is computerized, and, due to the large volume of entries, office staff will be able to welcome post-entries up to **ONE HOUR** before the session starts. The office will then close for that hour to prepare for the session. Once the session starts, the office will reopen, and, if possible, the staff will make every effort to include new entries for the current session that are made at least three classes ahead. Entry forms may be downloaded and printed from the Lake County Fair's website. Please make sure the formatting is correctly positioned on the paper before printing. The website address is:

Coggins – As we are subject to surprise inspections, we request that all out-of-state exhibitors have their Coggins verification forms with them while at the show.

Camping – Camping arrangements will be made with LCAS personnel. **The cost is \$25 per night without electric and \$35 per night with electric. NO TENTS!**



Only exhibitors showing in the horse show in the arena for the designated dates and time period may camp in the camping lot next to the Horse Barn. That is: NO workers, helpers, friends etc. are allowed in the Horse Barn camping area. Anyone else is welcome to camp in the regular campgrounds, located at the northwest corner of the fairgrounds.



Golf Carts

No golf cars or motorized vehicles of any kind are allowed on the fairgrounds except for vendors, concessionaires, police, fair officials and service oriented (medical) vehicles. Superintendents may only use the vehicle on the day(s) of their own show. All persons must register with the Concessions Office, show proof of liability insurance for the vehicle, abide by the rules received, AND DISPLAY A PERMIT STICKER ON THE VEHICLE WHERE IT IS CLEARLY VISIBLE.

Rules and Regulations

The Lake County Fair will take every precaution to properly protect exhibits and/or animals. However, we will not be liable for the safety of exhibits, animals, exhibitors, employees, or families. Nor will we be liable for losses or damages sustained due to vandalism, theft, weather, fire, accidents, or any other cause. Exhibitors wishing to insure themselves, their belongings or their livestock may do so at their own expense. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that may be occasioned to any person or any animal or damage to any property while on the grounds by a horse owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the management against all legally established claims or damages of any kind or nature that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by him. Presentation of an entry blank shall be deemed acceptance of these rules.

Exhibitors are hereby notified that any act of discourtesy or disobedience to judges and/or officials on the part of the exhibitor shall forfeit his entry, stall fees, and prize money. The Horse Show Committee shall have the power to bar an offender from further competition and have him/her and his entire exhibit removed from the grounds. The Horse Show shall not be held liable for damages of any kind as a result of such action and this shall be accepted as a condition of entry. Horses must be kept under control and, if not, at the discretion of the judge, they may not be allowed to compete. Owner will forfeit entry fees in this case.

NOTICE: You cannot enter the fairgrounds with horses or campers until 12:00 p.m. on August 5, 2010. All stalls and campers must be out by 8:00 a.m. on Monday, August 9, 2010

ARENA SCHOOLING HOURS

If there is enough time, we will open the arena in between sessions for working your horses. The ring being open in between sessions is NOT guaranteed.

SHOW OFFICE HOURS

Office Hours will be posted at the show.

We are very grateful to all of you, our exhibitors. Because of you, the show office is a very busy place. However, we need to take good care of our office staff, so though we will do everything in our power to accommodate our exhibitors, we must make sure the staff receives adequate consideration for personal needs. Please respect posted show office hours and entry rules for their sake.

PARKING

All trailers must be in the designated areas. This effort is being instituted to make more parking readily available for fairgoers and exhibitors alike.

GENERAL CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

♦Any class designated with A/HA are for purebred Arabians (A) or Half-Arabians (HA). If no such designation or specific breed is listed with the class name, then the class is open and any breed may enter utilizing the proper equipment for that class (i.e. Western equipment or English equipment).

If you buy a stall for your horse, **YOU DO NOT HAVE TO PAY THE GROUNDS FEE LISTED IN THIS PRIZE LIST.** If you intend to tie your horse to your trailer, then **YOU PAY THE GROUNDS FEE ONLY. DO NOT PAY THE FEE FOR A STALL.** Please Note: A grounds fee is charged because additional maintenance must be done to return the fairgrounds back to its original park-like condition after the horse shows have ended.

Warm Up Arena

The warm-up ring attached to the main arena is for use by exhibitors one class ahead of their entered class. All other warm-up must be done behind the barns. Thank you.
